Where do plants and animals live?

Art and Design Technology

The children will look at pivots and levers and ways that can use these to create model animals that move.

Geography

In Geography we will be developing our skills of using maps and Atlases and investigating and exploring weather and climates around the world.

PE

During PE the children will explore games skills and developing their own games. They will also be preparing for Sports Day by developing some of their athletics skills.

RE

In RE the children will finish exploring the topics of Rules before moving onto our final topic of RE this year focuses on the theme of Treasures, consider our Global Church family.

ICT

This term we will be linking our geography skills to ICT and using the programmable Beetbots to move around maps.

English

In English this term the children will be developing their story writing skills using the work of the author Anthony Browne, comparing some of the stories that he wrote. We will also then go onto look at information texts and researching and writing our own. We will also continue to build upon our Punctuation, grammar and Spelling Skills.

Maths

In Maths we will continue to build upon our skills in the areas of calculations including place value, addition, subtraction and division through exploring money and time.

Science-Microhabitats

This topic will involve us looking at smaller local habitats and the animals and plants that live there. They will look at the environment and what we can do to preserve the natural habitats of the world we live in.
