## Marking and Feedback

### What is the purpose of Marking and Feedback?

Marking and feedback is an integral part of teaching and learning. It is how we let our pupils know how well they are progressing with their learning. As teachers it provides us with information that helps us to plan future lessons that will best support the children in our class to achieve their absolute potential. It helps us with our on going assessment of pupils and enables us to build up evidence to show how children have progressed from one level to the next in all areas across the curriculum.

### Are children given opportunities to assess their own and others learning?

At the very centre of our aims we strive to create independent learners who are able to reflect on their own and others learning and make assessments of the progress they are making. In school we have a visual marking code policy which children are taught how to use. Through this they clearly understand the feedback they are given but can also, when asked assess their own or others work. Peer assessment occurs predominantly in KS2 classes and all children throughout the school are able to self-assess in some form whether using thumbs up activities or the traffic lights coding system.

### What do teachers mark and how do we give your child feedback?

We use the marking policy outlined on the next page to mark every piece of work in every subject using the key symbols and written comments. Teachers aim to provide more detailed feedback in our core subject areas of RE, English and Maths and aim to complete focused marking and feedback with each child at least once week. Oral feedback is of vital importance as children receive immediate responses and know where they need to go next. This is particularly useful in subjects such as PE in which children need to be told how successful they have been.
